CONSTITUTION OF THE CENTER

- The CFCUL was constituted at the Faculty of Sciences of Lisbon University **on the basis of Prof. Andrade e Silva's scholar tradition**
- The CFCUL was constituted **in 25.07.2003**
- The **funding** of the CFCUL began only in **2004**

However

- Before the official creation of the CFCUL, in 2003, a team **of 7 Profs submitted to FCT the Project "Scientific Culture. Conceptual Migrations and Social Contaminations"**
(rate: excellent)
- It was in the context of this project that the CFCUL emerged. In fact, this project was the laboratory in which the CFCUL team had its **first experience as a research unit**





THE CFCUL

CFCUL is the only research unit in Portugal exclusively dedicated to Philosophy of Science

The CFCUL aims

- to promote the **development of the Philosophy of Science in Portugal** by doing **research** as well as by offering **graduate and post-graduate training**
- **to fulfill the gap in Epistemology and Philosophy of Science existing in Portugal**
- to **disseminate** knowledge in the area of Philosophy of Science, both in the scientific community and in the public space

CFCUL's structure has the following specificities:

- It is constituted at the **university level**. It does not duplicate the structure of a single department nor even of a single faculty. On the contrary, it includes people from several faculties and departments within the University of Lisbon and other universities
- It is **largely interdisciplinary** with people from diverse areas and scientific backgrounds
- It has a **strong international scope**, both in its members, collaborators and research partnerships

CFCUL has a large conception of Science, reflecting the various theoretical questions of its members

In a tradition coming from **Leibniz, Husserl and Neurath** we believe that Science is like a continuous ocean “even if men distinguish parts in it and give them names according to their comfort”.








TEAM DISCIPLINARY BACKGROUND





- **Immaterial talks** – informal discussions taking place at libraries and bookshops



BACKGROUND

- This line of research follows the scientific program initiated in Portugal by Professor **J. Andrade e Silva** collaborator of the great french physicist the **Nobel Prize Louis de Broglie**



MAIN OBJECTIVES

This line of research was directed to the study of the **Philosophical Foundations of Quantum Physics**



Our aims were

- to study the conceptual analysis of the different philosophical positions involved in the interpretations of quantum physics.
- to submit the philosophical foundations supporting quantum physics - according to Copenhagen's interpretation - to a new critic analysis
- and furthermore to develop a philosophical foundation and a formalization of the nonlinear quantum physics that is now emerging.

In order to do so

- we have examined the connection of the mathematics with the reality and analyzed the epistemic implications of nonlinear quantum physics.



MAIN OBJECTIVES

- The year of **2003** began with the international publication of the book "**Towards a Nonlinear Quantum Physics**" by José Croca. In this book, in the sequence of de Broglie proposal, a modern version of the nonlinear quantum physics was developed in its fundamentals.
- As an extension of this book, the nonlinear master equation was solved for the most significant cases. Also a whole range of new solutions are now under close study.
- **The main goal of this research is the unity of all physics in the light of the Principle of Eurhythmy.**
- **The philosophical and epistemological implications of this principle are being developed**




MAIN OBJECTIVES

The principle of eurhythmy is an extension of quantum de Broglie guiding principle.

The guiding principle describes the quantum nonlinear interaction between the corpuscle and the guiding wave.

The principle of eurhythmy generalizes these ideas to all physics





This difficulty is related with the problem of two clock calibration in relativity. It was shown that it is possible to measure the one-way velocity of light with one single clock. In this way the problem of two clock calibration procedure is avoided.

ONGOING AND FUTURE RESEARCH

We intend to continue the Development of the Mathematical apparatus of Causal Nonlinear Quantum Physics

In particular, we aim:

- To proceed the study of the properties of the already found solutions of the nonlinear master equation and the new ones, namely in the non stationary case.
- To publish, in this period, a full work on the mathematical foundations of the nonlinear quantum physics, on the form of a book or in a series of articles.




ONGOING AND FUTURE RESEARCH

Other main topic of our research is Unity of Physics

The aim of this line of research is to continue the work in the unification of physics.

In order to do that, we intend:

- to develop formally the unity of physics by using the principle of eurhythmy to nonlinear systems, chaos and stochastic processes, stochastic equations and theory of probability
- to develop a Gravitational attraction law in the light of the principle of eurhythmy
- to develop a Coulomb law in the light of the principle of eurhythmy
- to derive the Maxwell equations as a natural consequence of the principle of eurhythmy





ONGOING AND FUTURE RESEARCH

We also intend :

- to study the philosophical implications of Fourier and wavelets analysis
- to study the philosophical consequences of the principle of eurhythmy
- to study the implications for the unity of science of the principle of eurhythmy



ONGOING AND FUTURE RESEARCH

Another of our aims is the development of the Philosophical Implications of the Nonlinear Causal Quantum Physics

Therefore, we aim to study:

- The concept of particle in the indeterminist linear quantum physics and in the modern causal nonlinear quantum physics.
- The concepts of causality and indeterminism, trajectory, localization and non-localization temporality and non-temporality in the light of the nonlinear theory.
- The philosophical implications of pragmatic approach to the Niels Bohr complementarity principle.

ONGOING AND FUTURE RESEARCH

Epistemology of Medicine

- Antonio Barbosa will give special attention to the **epistemological status of the communicative relation between patient and physician**.
- **A. Barbosa also intends to introduce a new subject**, "Relational Ethics", at the Medicine graduation (FML, Univ. Lisbon), where he teaches
- Nuno Nabais, João Sampaio and Barros Veloso will work out on the so called **Evidence Based Medicine**, confronting it with the phenomenological concept of Evidence in medical diagnosis.
- Nuno Nabais will give special attention to the **evidential experience of non-actual realities** in medical knowledge (protensions, probabilities, possibilities, risks, etc.).
- Barros Veloso (in collaboration with A. Barbosa) intends to do research on the **scientific relevance of the Lisbon School of Medicine in the 30ties and 40ties** in Portugal.
- Antonio Barbosa will work on the **morbility of the oncological patient** (Psychiatry Service/Hospital de Santa Maria, Lisbon) as a way of understanding patient 's experiences of their own illness in their search for a different meaning of life and death.
- António Barbosa is also leading a research team at his Psychiatry Service, which studies **New criteria to quality studies in consultation-liaison psychiatry**



ONGOING AND FUTURE RESEARCH

Bioethics

A. Barbosa (with the collaboration of Nuno Nabais) will continue the research on Bioethics which is being done at the **Master on Bioethics at the Faculty of Medicine** (coordinator: Prof. Barbosa).

A. Barbosa is also studying, on his own:

- **the correlation cost/benefits in the psychiatric liaison activity** at all the Lisbon University St. Mary's Hospital's services. This research is grounded on the re-elaboration of the "Justice" principle , where the efficacy indicators contemplate the principles of a relational ethics.
- **the problem of Data Confidentiality**, Bioethics Centre/Lisbon Fac. Medicine
- the tracking of clinical files throughout the wards and hospital clinics, in order **to detect and understand the possible factors contributing to confidentiality leaks**. This envisages: 1. to protect the patients confidentiality, 2. to avoid the apro priation of relevant information by external agents.

Evolutionism and Evolution Theories

F. Carrapico, H. Abreu, A. Levy and M. Pina are trying to do an update on the **epistemological and theoretical discussion concerning evolutionism**. This research - **with a strong outreach impact** - is connected with two issues:

- *the 200th anniversary of Charles Darwin's birth in 2009*
- *the need of counterbalancing the rising influence of Creationism in the USA, European and Portuguese context*





- The aim of this project is to study **the quality/quantity tension in economics as a philosophical issue**. The main focus is on the discussion of **economic modelling** - arguably the most distinctive feature of current mainstream economics - and of the logic(s) of economic investigation.
- This includes **research on the role and nature of economic models, the relationship between models and reality, the relevance of ordinary language and mathematics, the importance of interpretative reasoning, and the significance of "human" or "ordinary" logic** - a non-demonstrative form of logic associated to the names of J. M. Keynes and F. P. Ramsey - and related recent developments in non-classical logics as compared to other more traditional forms of logical reasoning.
- Assessing the foundations of a "qualitative tradition" in economics, which includes representatives of the discipline as notable as Alfred Marshall, J. M. Keynes and Ronald Coase, is part of this investigation.



ONGOING AND FUTURE RESEARCH



Philosophy of Literature and Linguistics

- To raise the main philosophical questions of literary studies and linguistics (methods of interpretation, implicit assumptions about the textual and/or the linguistic object, etc).
- **Reevaluate fiction as a critic concept for philosophy and human sciences, pointing out links with the logic of knowledge and the history of its institutions (and in this sense we work on heuristic fictions, concord fictions, modelling fictions, and so on).**
- To rethink, in the context of contemporary knowledge, **the question of poetics** – we mean: the inquire of our practices of writing–, beyond the restrict domain of literature, within history (Rancière), psychoanalysis (Freud), anthropology (Pavel), etc.







Unity of Science



BACKGROUND

- This RG has also emerged in the context of the **FCT Project "Scientific Culture. Conceptual Migrations and Social Contaminations"**
- Unity of Science is not only one more RG. It is a main determination of the CFCUL which is largely organized on the basis of a **huge conception of science** and of a truly **interdisciplinary team**
- In our view, Unity of Science does not coincide with any strong program, more or less reductionist.
- On the contrary, we look for an approach to Unity of Science in the line of **Leibniz and Neurath Encyclopaedism**





MAIN OBJECTIVES

- to discover the **main categories** involved in the **Idea of Unity of Science** and to point out its more important theorizations;
- to identify some of the **exemplary programs** of Unity of Science (Bacon, Leibniz, Diderot, Neurath) and to systematically discuss the diversity of ways of conceiving the realization of the Idea of Unity of Science which were proposed in each case;
- to draw up a balance of the materializations which Unity of Science has given rise to, of the institutional structures in which it has been displayed, of the mechanisms which have been put forward aiming at its promotion (1. Scientific Community, 2. School, 3. Museum, 4. Encyclopaedia, and 5. Library)
- **to question the interdisciplinary nature of Science in the XX Century**, to understand its more eloquent manifestations, to study relevant cases of the actual scientific interdisciplinary activity, both in terms of practices, heuristic procedures and institutional structures.
- to look for a **combinatory and plural conception of Unity of Science**, able to thought out the transversal rationality which (today as yesterday; now, perhaps, more than before) links the different disciplines






let me call your attention to the transversal character of the **Unity of Science** within our Unit


Unity of Science is a tendency which crosses all the other RGs



- The SAHFC is a new Department of the FCUL


